- the Twilight Zone (Staff Development)
- Envy, Pride and Greed (Integrity Testing)

The Dark Triad

- Machiavellianism ("Keep your enemies close")
- Narcissism ("Watch out for injured pride")
- Psychopathy ("Inability to feel remorse or shame")

The Dark Side

- Excitable: moody, hard to please, and emotionally volatile (Psychopathy)
- Sceptical: suspicious, sensitive to criticism, expecting betrayal (Machiavellianism)
- Bold: overly self-confident, arrogant, and entitled (Narcissism)

| Passive-Aggressive | Independent | Become stubbornly non-cooperative | |
| PARANOID | Vigilant | Become suspicious and distrustful | |
| Schizoid | Introverted | Become emotionally detached | |
| Schizotypal | Original | Resort to the paranormal | |
| Avoidant | Cautious | Freeze through embarrassment | |
| Dependent | Docile | Become emotionally clinging | |
| PSYCHOPATHY | Affective | Manipulate the emotions of others | |
| Antisocial | Nonconformist | Become aggressive with no regrets | |

Testing for integrity

- Carelessness, sloppiness
- Lateness, absenteeism
- Hostility, intimidation, racist/sexist attitudes
- Disciplinary problems, 'chip on shoulder'
- Disrespect for seniors, overbearing behaviour
- Theft of company property, unwillingness to share
- Inability to cope with change

Giotto Integrity Test

- Carelessness
- Absenteeism
- Hostility
- Inertia
- Disciplinary problems (Envy) Machiavellianism
- Disrespect of authority (Pride) Narcissism
- Theft of company property (Greed) Psychopathy

- 'There always seems to be at least one difficult person within every team'

Narcissism

Pride, Vices and Virtues, Giotto, Athena Chapel, Padua, 1287



- Vain Arrogant
- Egotistical Conceited
- Opinionated
- Disloyal
- Self-centred
- 'I am particularly skilled at asking penetrating questions'

Machiavellianism

Greed, Vices and Virtues, Giotto, Athena Chapel, Padua, 1287



- Covetous
- Crafty
- Envious
- Spiteful
- Unappreciative
- Grasping
- 'I have no problem twisting the truth when necessary'
